



Tyson Foods Recalls Foodservice Chicken Due to Undeclared Allergen  
No reported illnesses associated with affected product

Springdale, Arkansas – August 7, 2008 – Tyson Foods, Inc., in cooperation with USDA, has voluntarily recalled 51,360 pounds of uncooked, foodservice chicken due to an undeclared soy-based allergen. There have been no reported illnesses associated with this product; however, the company has initiated the recall as a precautionary measure.

Tyson has been in the process of reducing the number of allergens in the company's foodservice products and produced some products with the old formulation while prematurely using a new label. The products were produced at the company's Vicksburg, Mississippi, location between July 23, 2008, and August 5, 2008.

The products were distributed to foodservice customers. The item distributed by Gordon Food Service<sup>®</sup>, Inc. that is included in this recall is as follows:
