HIGHLIGHTS

ARIZONA-CALIFORNIA DESERT HEAT

This region is experiencing a significant heat wave with temperatures close to 20° above seasonal norms. Quality and shelf-life concerns will likely develop in lettuce, tender leaf, and other key desert row crops throughout the industry.

BROCCOLI

Markets are low; supplies remain widely available. Although quality is very good, some lots are exhibiting small crowns following weeks of cold weather. This week's higher temperatures will boost yields and crown size but could increase insect pressure.

GREEN LEAF, ICEBERG, AND ROMAINE

Prices are fairly steady at low levels; yields are high in the Arizona-California desert growing region.



CUCUMBERS

- Prices are weak.
- Supplies are abundant in Mexico. The Florida season is getting underway; offshore stocks are also available.

BROCCOLINI

- Increased demand and low industry volume have led to elevated markets.
- Supplies are expected to rebound by mid-March.

STRAWBERRIES

- Clear weather is forecast for the California growing regions over the next 10 days.
- Expect prices to inch down.
