## HIGHLIGHTS

#### **POTATOES**

Expect falling prices as the season moves into September. As the industry transitions from storage to new crop potatoes, advanced orders and maintaining tight inventories are highly recommended.

#### **CAULIFLOWER**

The market hit its peak and has started to ease as warmer weather is promoting growth and increasing yields.

#### **BLUEBERRIES**

Supplies are diminishing in California's San Joaquin Valley; production is winding down. Pacific Northwest volume is starting to decrease. Expect markets to rise.



#### **ONIONS**

- The Northwest onion season is off to a strong start with Washington. Oregon, and Idaho fresh-run onion harvests in full swing. Colorado and Utah are ramping up as New Mexico winds down.
- Markets are steady at lower levels.

#### **ORANGES**

- The California Valencia crop is dominated by large sizes (56- and 88-count pieces); small supplies (88- and 138-count oranges) are tightening.
- With many schools' seasons underway and many more starting in the coming weeks, small oranges will become limited.

#### **ASPARAGUS**

- Prices are escalating.
- Jumbo and large sizes are extremely limited.

 $\frac{1}{4}$  C + 2 T RSS Washed & Trimmed Cilantro, chopped

2 cloves **RSS** Peeled Garlic MFC Limes, juiced 1 T Mavonnaise dise Tamarind paste

Asian chile sauce of your choice 1 T

½ tsp. Fish sauce 1 tsp. Sugar 2 T Water

½ C Grapeseed oil

2 heads MFC Living Butter Lettuce, washed and torn from roots

MFC Fennel, sliced and grilled 2 small

Corn, shucked, grilled, and cut from cobs 2 ears

MFC Oranges, sliced and grilled 2 large

Pulse the first nine ingredients together in a blender until smooth. Drizzle in oil until dressing is emulsified. Hand toss MFC Living Butter Lettuce with dressing. Artfully arrange equal portions of fennel, corn, and oranges on top of butter lettuce. Garnish with extra cilantro and serve.
