#### **APPLES**

Expect slightly higher prices for small Gala and Honeycrisp supplies. Markets for other MFC varieties are stable.

#### **GREEN ONIONS**

Recent heavy rains across the desert growing regions have increased markets and reduced yields.



#### GREEN LEAF, ICEBERG, & ROMAINE

- Markets are easing as Arizona-California desert production ramps up.
- Weights are increasing as favorable weather promotes growth.

#### CALIFORNIA STRAWBERRIES

- · California supplies remain extremely limited due to the rains and lower temperatures of the past two weeks.
- Mexican berries (into South Texas) and Florida-grown supplies are increasing; quality is improving. Expect markets to decline slowly over the next 10 days.

- Pricing remains steady; small sizes are meeting demand.

With all the traditionally heavy ingredients coming into play on winter menus, citrus can add brightness and flavor contrast. How do you suggest chefs do this?



Citrus definitely breaks up the richness and fattiness of heavier winter ingredients like braised meats or stewed vegetables.



You can easily add the juice or zest directly into a dish or even use the zest to make a quick gremolata that adds herbs and a crunchy texture.



Also, consider a simple citrus granita to lighten up a fresh seafood appetizer. My personal favorite is pink peppercorn grapefruit granita on raw oysters.



# Grilled Octopus, Baby Artichokes, and Preserved Lemons

Visually stunning with global flavors, this on-trend dish can also be made with scallops or shrimp.

1 lb. Octopus, cleaned

1 C White wine

3 cloves RSS Peeled Garlic, smashed 2 MFC Lemons, quartered

Baby artichokes, cleaned, halved, and steamed until tender

Olive oil for frying


1/2 C Preserved lemon 2 C Frisée lettuce 1/3 C Lemon-avocado oil

Kosher salt and freshly cracked black pepper, to taste

Harissa sauce (optional)

Simmer octopus in white wine, garlic, one chopped lemon, and enough water to cover for approximately one hour (or until tender). Drain and cool. Brush with one tablespoon of lemon-avocado oil and grill until slightly charred (four minutes per side). Slice and reserve. Fry artichoke halves in batches in hot oil; drain. Squeeze one lemon over artichokes and season with salt and pepper.

Arrange equal portions of octopus, artichokes, preserved lemon, and frisée on plates: drizzle with remaining lemon-avocado oil. Garnish with Harissa sauce (optional).
